TARIFF CHANGES

Any products that are not CUSMA (Canada-United States-Mexico Agreement)-approved may be subject to:

- Base tariffs
- Section 232
- Section 338

TARIFF CHANGES

Products classified as informational materials (magazines, books, CDs, vinyls, etc) are currently **exempt from tariffs** and can be shipped to the U.S. duty-free. This also applies to Section 301 tariffs.

Certain countries have 'conditional' Section 301 tariff rates that are capped at 10% or 12.5%

TARIFF CHANGES

Base • Percentage of the product's declared value • Some cases assessed based on the weight	Section 232 "Metal tariff" • Products containing iron, aluminum, copper, or steel. • Base + • Not CUSMA exempt
Section 301 • Products made (country of origin) in the 60 countries - incl Canada • 10% or 12.5% • Brazil 25% • look for the "/1" footnote	Section 338 NEW AUG 19 • Certain industries • Additional 50%

Section 122 - removed

SECTION 338

CUSMA preferential treatment does not apply to affected HTS codes for this tariff category when the country of origin is Canada.

Country of origin is the United States or Mexico, CUSMA preferential treatment will continue to apply.

CUSMA CERTIFICATION

- Chit Chats account
 - Settings/ Shipping/ Manage CUSMA Certification
- Fast approval for eligible HTS
- Valid for 1 year

- Exporter = you
- Producer = mfg of goods
- Add goods: HTS code, country of origin
